

GP ICE Download User Guide

Overview

ICE download allows GP practice ICE users to select reports belonging to their patients which were not requested by their practice e.g. UHL inpatient or outpatient reports to be 'downloaded' via ICE service into the practice system. The results on collection by the practice system via the NHS MESH network will then be integrated into the practice clinical patient record.

Using the ICE download button

The ICE reports view will display a download button on the right hand side to indicate the report is available for download as per the example screenshot below.

On clicking a download button you will be presented with a select recipient dialogue box with a dropdown, choose the GP whom the report should be downloaded for.
